Morning: visit of the Gramont castle (10 minutes driving)

In 2021, the Château de Gramont will host the exhibition «Ruffs and Farthin- gales" which will look at Renaissance fashion on screen.

The exhibition will take you on a journey through the history of fashion with its display of costumes created for the big screen. It will also express the link between Cinema and History.

The presentation will include an educational chronology of the evolution of fashion from the end of the 14th century to the beginning of the 17th century. It will help the public learn how dressmakers of the Renaissance, just like the painters and sculptors of the time, designed and modelled the human body using embellishments and the treasures of the era: brocade, velvet, silk, lace, jewellery, etc. Visitors will also learn about the profession of costume desi- gner. Information about the specific features of the clothing, hidden symbols and many unusual and surprising anecdotes will highlight the interpretation of storylines and the fashion of the Renaissance.

2:30/3:00p.m. : Lectoure avec Brice guided visit with a guide from office de tourisme Gascogne Lomagne

Perched on a promontory in the heart of the Lomagne gersoise, Lectoure, labeled "Most beautiful detour of France", is adorned with a belt of ramparts from which emerge beautiful





stone houses, gardens, fountains, alleys, old mansions, the thermal baths, the Gothic—Cathedral of Saint-Gervais and the Museum of Sacred Art, the castle of the Counts of Armagnac (today a village of Antiques stores)... It is in Lectoure that the pastel is cultivated whose incomparable blue has made the reputation of the Cocagne region. The Atelier du Bleu retraces the history and the use of this small plant which made the wealth of the Midi Toulousain in the 16th century. Every year in July/August, the city hosts the Eté Photographique, a festival of contemporary photos whose exhibitions are presented in 5 major places in the city.

05:00 p.m.: Visit of Domaine d'Arton, wines and Armagnacs.

Patrick de Montal is the owner and harvester of the estate. He grows his vines with the greatest care, raises his wines, distills them to elaborate in his cellars a range of Armagnacs with a unique roundness and smoothness. Creator of the Blanche d'Armagnac in 1985 with Fine Blanche®, Patrick de Montal received in 2017 the Prix d'Excellence at the Concours Général Agricole: it is the first time that the Prix d'Excellence is awarded to an Armagnac. Château Arton resurrects the Haut Armagnac appellation, and delicately exalts the secrets of a terroir too long forgotten. Its uniqueness makes Haut Armagnac a land of innovation.

Check in at l'Hôtel**** Collège des Doctrinaires

The College of Doctrinaires was originally an educational institution, founded in 1630, and the building was transformed into an annex of the city's hospital in 1800. After the closure of the hospital in 2006, it was rehabilitated in 2018 to be transformed into a 4-star Hotel Residence and Spa which benefits from a direct access, by an underground passage crossing the National street, to the hotel of Goulard where the thermal baths of Lectoure are. On this occasion it will regain its former name, the Hotel du Collège des Doctrinaires, opened in 2019. Cross this historical place by the courtyard of honor with its climbing roses and its fragrant wisteria before crossing the threshold of the Collège des Doctrinaires, and come to discover the lounge of honor with its monumental stone fireplace for a welcome drink...
