Based on the work of the famous decipherer of hieroglyphs, the collections tell the story of the fabulous adventure of writing and invite you to travel through the cultures of the whole world. On your way out, don't miss the Place des Ecritures and its famous giant reconstruction of the" Rosette Stone".

Departure for Saint-Cirq-Lapopie

1 -Either through the Lot Valley (1 hour).

Route towards the Lot valley passing through the villages of Faycelles, Saint-Pierre-Toirac and its fortified church and Larroque-Toirac and its castle nestled against the cliff, Cajarc, Cénevières...

Or













2 - by way of the Célé Valley (allow 1 hour)

The Célé, a fresh and lively tributary of the Lot, undulates in a wild and poetic course. As you follow its course, the rock faces open up and reveal their dark caves decorated with prehistoric drawings, their pretty villages and their troglodyte houses. On the way, don't forget to stop at Marcilhac-sur-Célé and Espagnac Sainte-Eulalie, St Sulpice... to admire their superb abbey and priory, Cabrerets and Saint-Cirq-Lapopie.

Perched on a cliff overlooking a meander of the Lot, Saint-Cirq Lapopie is a masterpiece of the medieval period. Dominated by the fortified church, the houses with their sloping roofs covered with brown tiles, reveal their harmonious volumes along the picturesque streets. A place that charmed artists and writers such as André Breton who made the village his summer residence.

This village of 220 inhabitants - 35 in winter! - was elected "Favorite Village of the French" in 2012. PRACTICAL INFO: Large P4 car park at the top of the village (pass the village).

A timeless interlude, a living encyclopaedia of the cultures and skills of life in the Quercy countryside in the 19th and early 20th centuries.

Imagine a 20-hectare route with twenty or so thematic stops presenting: the trades of yesteryear, the blacksmith, the baker, the clog maker... the thatched houses, life on the farm and its animals... etc. There are also nearly 8000 objects that come to life in the museum.

Two many other main points of interest in the historic center:

Musée de la Mode: near the covered Market and Ste Cecilia place) This one of the strong identities of the Fashion Museum is to present a completely new exhibition every two years, always centred on a different theme. Each exhibit is then returned to its reserve. The museum presents clothes and accessories from the private collection of Dominique Miraille, from the end of the 17th century to the 2000s. In 2022, the fashion museum will present "10 years", the anniversary exhibition

- Musée Lapérouse: this museum is dedicated to the fabulous round-the-world trip of the Albi sailor, Lapérouse. To access this museum, one crosses the Pont Vieux to reach Botany Bay Square. From this terrace you can appreciate one of the finest panoramas of the Episcopal City: the river, the scows on the Tarn, the roofs of Old Alby.
