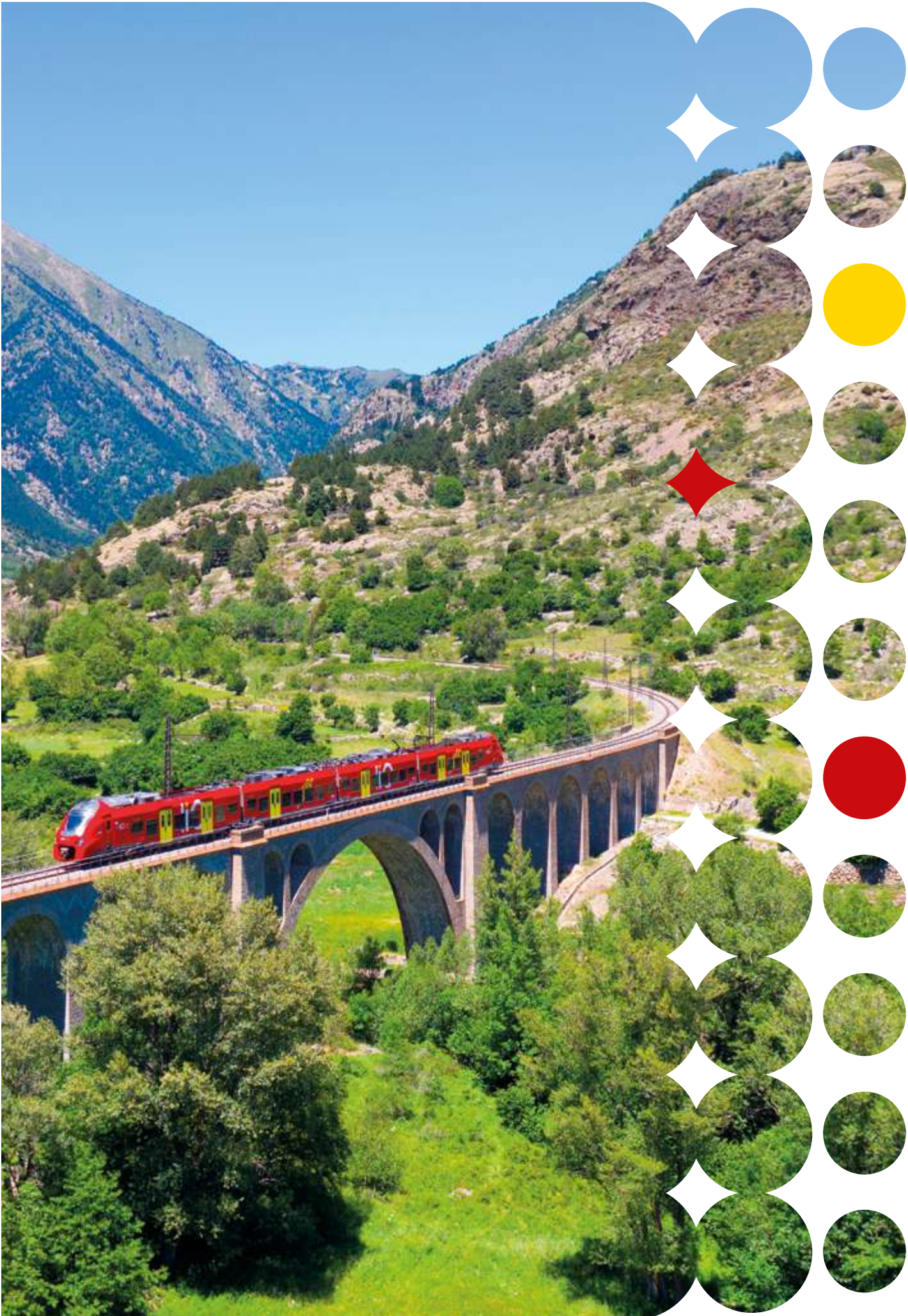

The Occitanie Rail Tour isn't just eco-friendly as it reduces its users' carbon footprint; it's people-friendly and budget-friendly too. It provides discounted rates for young travellers (18-26 years old) and enables train users to switch down a gear and make the most of the experiences along the way. The regional council has implemented a fixed rate for the end of 2022 to encourage people to travel by train: 1€ tickets for any journey in Occitanie on the first weekend of the month (except in July and August).

The Occitanie Rail Tour is a pillar of the Occitanie Tourist Board's marketing campaign and an eco-friendly way to explore the Occitanie Sud de France destination using regional trains (or coaches).

The Occitanie Rail Tour takes travellers on all or some of the routes detailed to experience Fabulous Voyages in (and leaving from) each of the listed station stops. The Occitanie Tourist Board website provides an interactive map to help travellers design their own journey. It includes the top 10 things to do within 40 minutes of the station stops, a selection of 3-5* accommodation nearby, contact details for Tourist Information and stations plus a direct link to the SNCF - TER Occitanie website to book train tickets. There are twenty identified routes so visitors can explore most of Occitanie's Grand Sites with the fifty-odd station stops taking them there.

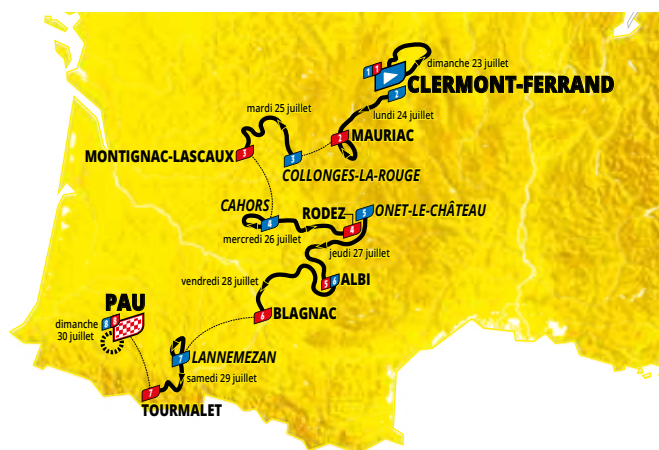
LOT - TARN-ET-GARONNE

LA VAGABONDE®, A 500KM INTERREGIONAL BIKE ROUTE



A Vagabonde® is a cycling adventure covering over 500km and taking cyclists (by summer 2023) as far as Montech in Tarn-et-Garonne, starting in Montluçon in Allier then through Limousin and Lot. The diverse and beautiful route brings cyclists incredible scenery in Northern Occitanie: from the Dordogne Valley and Garonne orchards to Causses du Quercy Regional Nature Park, Quercy Blanc or Montauban and its stunning main square.

Bike-friendly Ténarèze Tourist Information is the first in the département to be approved by "Accueil Vélo" and provides bike repair kitslations « Saint Chinian », « Faugères », « Minervois » et « Saint Jean du Minervois ».

The GR® From Avene Lake to Salagou Lake hiking trail in Hérault links two major local attractions: Avene Lake and Salagou Lake. The GR® Minervois, Saint-Chinian, Faugères Tours hiking trail provides 5 loops lasting 2-3 days to explore vineyards, scenery and heritage deep in the Saint Chinian, Faugères, Minervois and Saint Jean du Minervois wine designation areas

PECTEN MAXIMUS, A SEASHELL SHELTER ON THE WAY OF ST JAMES



An amazing place to stay has sprung up in the great outdoors near the Way of St James in Limogne-en-Quercy Designed by the artist Sara de Gouy, Pecten Maximus is made of... scallop shells! A symbolic nod to the pilgrims' symbol and the area's geological past: this spot was under the sea millions of years ago ... Pecten Maximus is open to everyone and is the second Lot installation from the Fenêtres sur le Paysage artistic project, designed by Derrière le Hublot in partnership with Causses du Quercy Regional Nature Park.

TOULOUSE (HAUTE-GARONNE)

LES HALLES DE LA CARTOUCHERIE, A THIRD PLACE DEVOTED TO FOOD AND DRINK

Les Halles de la Cartoucherie opened in Toulouse's first eco-neighbourhood on the 1st weekend of September. The multi-functional venue brings several themed areas together in its 3 buildings whose architecture captures the city's industrial past. Get your tastebuds tingling in the 3000m² food hall where 30 stands serve international street food. A brewery, coworking space and performance venue complete the picture at this quirky third place in a thriving part of the city..."

LE GRAU-DU-ROI (GARD)

LE GRAU-DU-ROI (GARD) L'ESPIQUETTE LIGHTHOUSE, A WATCHTOWER OVER THE CAMARGUE GARDOISE

From spring 2023, visitors can cross the dunes on a wooden footbridge to help take care of this fragile ecosystem and visit L'Espiguette lighthouse. Climb to the top for 360° views of a miniature Sahara and the sea on one side, Aigues-Mortes and the Camargue salt marshes on the other. A display area in the main building presents the site's history and the role of lighthouses on the coastline

LA MONGIE (HAUTES-PYRÉNÉES)

LA MAISON DU TOURMALET PIC DU MIDI LAUNCH

La Maison du Tourmalet - Pic du Midi is preparing to open on Col du Tourmalet. The Pic du Midi visitor centre houses a 15m diameter dome where visitors can watch an immersive film about the night and night experience: legends, fears, magical starry sky, biodiversity etc. Visitors can relive the history of the Tour de France that made Col du Tourmalet world-famous in the other rooms.

AGDE (HÉRAULT)

CHÂTEAU LAURENS, A RARE EXAMPLE OF ART NOUVEAU IN OCCITANIE

Château Laurens, an ornate villa built in 1897 over the River Hérault with views of Agde old town, opens to visitors on Saturday June 10th 2023 for World Art Nouveau Day. The building's extraordinary architectural style captures the energy of art movements at the dawn of the 20th century.

The unique villa's history ties into the life of Agde's very own Emmanuel Laurens, the heir to a huge fortune. The globe-trotting music lover had a weakness for avant-garde art movements, as you can tell from his home.

MONTPELLIER (HÉRAULT)

VILLA DES CENT REGARDS, ART DECO IN ALL ITS GLORY

Victor Grazi fled fascism and his native Lombardy at the very end of the 19th century and moved to Montpellier in the 30s. He built his dream home on a vineyard he bought in 1950: a miniature castle built entirely from concrete (even the doors and shutters). He devoted his

life to his grand design and got the whole family involved.

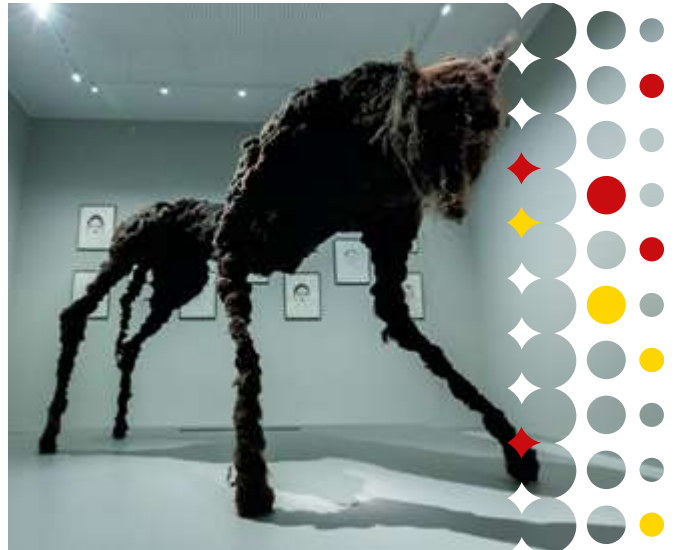
MUSEUMS IN THE SPOTLIGHT

MENDE (LOZÈRE)

GÉVAUDAN MUSEUM, A STONE HAVEN CELEBRATING A DELICIOUSLY MYSTERIOUS LAND

The brand new Gévaudan Museum has just opened to visitors in two outstanding 17th century buildings listed as Monuments Historiques. It's already approved as a "Musée de France" and its collections showcase the rich heritage of Lozère, the former royal province of Gévaudan, from prehistoric times to the present day, not forgetting the legendary "beast of Gévaudan"

NISSAN-LEZ-ENSÉRUNE (HÉRAULT)

ENSÉRUNE ARCHAEOLOGICAL MUSEUM AND OPPIDUM RENOVATION



The Oppidum was inhabited from 600 BC to the 1st century AD. It stands 100m high on a plain and has been brought to life by a little museum which opened in 1937. Under the Centre des Monuments Nationaux's guidance, a brand new next-generation establishment has just opened with a fantastic collection of antique vases and an educational focus presenting the different civilisations that lived here (Celts, Greeks, Iberians, Etruscans, Romans) and their funeral rites.

MONTPELLIER

PARCELLE 473, A PRIVATE STREET AND CONTEMPORARY ART MUSEUM



Laurent Rigail works in the Montpellier art trade and decided to open his own street and contemporary art in a former family wine storehouse. 473 is the number of the last plot still planted with vines. The 480m² centre has stayed true to its winemaking legacy and hosts pieces by leading street artists from the gallery owner's personal collection, artist donations and loans from private collectors. The idea is to host workshops for children and artist experiences

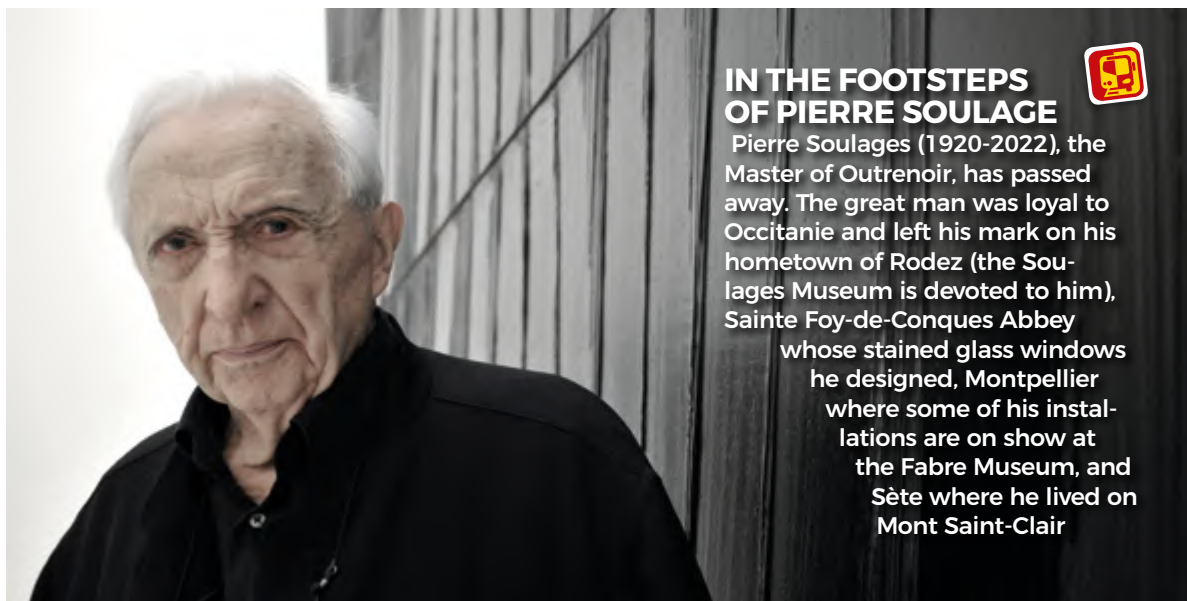
CASTRES (TARN)

THE GOYA MUSEUM GETS A MAKEOVER



After over two years of renovations, the Goya Museum is reopening to the public with a new visitor experience and twice the surface area. That will make it the biggest Hispanic art museum in France, after the Louvre. Inside a 17th century bishop's palace designed by Jules-Hardouin Mansart, one of the architects behind Versailles, you can gaze at ornate canvases and engravings by Goya alongside a fascinating Gaudí series by Joan Miró.

The most famous musketeer and pride of Gascony (he was born in Lupiac, 25 miles from Auch) died during the Battle of Maastricht in 1673 (Belgium). To celebrate the 350th anniversary of his tragic death, the Gers countryside bursts to life with a whole host of events all summer long. The heart of the action will of course be the village of Lupiac (famous for its d'Artagnan Museum and d'Artagnan chez d'Artagnan Festival - August 13th this year) whilst the hero's followers can explore the sculptures in tribute to the legend throughout the département (in Lupiac, Auch and Condom). www.lupiac.fr/?lang=en
