

Press trip From Friday, 28 April to Tuesday, 2 May

## By boat From Hérault to Little Camargue

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Fri 28.04.

- Arrival by 5 pm and check-in of the boats
- Briefing 5.30 pm 6.30 pm with short test drive
- 7.00 pm : leave the boat and take your bikes to go to the oysterfarm Noisette d'Oc (Le Mourre Blanc – 34140 Mèze - <u>www.lanoisettedoc.com</u>)
- 7.30 pm : meet Jean-François Pouget (+33 (0)6 85 93 02 52), Marketing and Communication Director at Hérault Tourisme, and Karine & Yvan Caussel (+33 (0)6 89 84 41 23), oysterfarmers

Enjoy a shellfish meal there - be aware that in oysterfarms, you can only eat mussels and oyters (raw or cooked), shrimps and sea snails.

• First night in the harbour of Meze

Sat 29.04.

- **9.30 am :** go by bike to **Domaine Saint-André** (route de Marseillan 34140 Mèze <u>https://domainesaintandre.com/</u>)
- 10.00 am : meet elise (+33 (0)4 99 04 94 73) ou jullie billod (+33 (0)6 79 62 27) visit of Domaine Saint André and wine tasting
- Trip to Frontignan Meze Frontignan 8 km, around 1 hour and 30 minutes (bridge of Frontignan opens twice a day : 9.30 am or 4 pm)
- After having passed the bridge at 4pm, let the boat and go by bike to the beach in Frontignan
  7.30 pm : dinner in Frontignan at restaurant on the beach Le Poisson Rouge julie Lorlut

Sun 30.04.

- 9.00 am : Arnaud (+33 (0)6 13 78 78 39) of Sète Grand Tour (<u>https://www.facebook.com/decouvrirseteautrement/?locale=fr\_FR</u>) will pick you up at your boat with his minibus for a visit in English of Sète. He will let you then in front of the Halles, the covered market of Sète, for lunch.
- Lunch in Les Halles et Manger, inside the covered market (<u>https://www.hallesetmanger.fr/</u>) +33 (0)6 62 82 55 22)
- **voya**. After lunch, Arnaud will pick you up again to make the transfer to Frontignan.





- Return to the boat for **2.00 pm**
- Trip to the island of Maguelone Frontignan Maguelone, 13 km 1 hour and 45 minutes
- Moor the boat at Pilou (<u>https://goo.gl/maps/i3YxDkL55uY76zvS9</u>) You'll have to cross the bridge to go to the cathedral and then to the beach. *Be aware that the bridge will be available until 7.45 pm.*

The best will be to go to the cathedral, and then to the beach, by bicycle.

- 4.30 pm : Visit of the island and cathedral with audio-guides in German <u>https://compagnons-de-maguelone.org/visiter-la-presquile/</u> Present yourself at the entrance to ask for the audio-guides. (the cathedral closes at 6.00 pm, so you may manage to begin the visit with the audio-guides at least at 5.00 pm)
- Beach don't forget to come-back to the bridge before it moves (at least at 7.45 pm)
- Overnight stay in Maguelone dinner on the boat

Mon 01.05.

- Ride to Aigues Mortes Maguelone Aigues Mortes, 27,5 km, 3 hours and 30 minutes
- Horse riding, guided tour of the town
- Evening meal with Gipsy Music

Tue 02.05.

- Return trip to Lattes with lock (how long does it take comfortably from Aigues Mortes?) Aigues Mortes - Lattes, 28 km, 3 hours, and 45 minutes, 1 lock
- Short visit of the harbour (maybe a little farewell snack with Greg & Juliette?)
- Approx. 13h transfer to the airport
- Return flight MPL from 15:30h
