Canal du Midi

With its 328 works of art and a unique landscape shaped by man, the canal du Midi is a true gem boasting an outstanding natural and built heritage. The technical feat of its excavation in the 17th century is a remarkable civil engineering achievement. This is why it has been listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site since 1996. A genuine link between the lands it passes through, the canal bears witness to successive eras and leaves an astonishingly diverse legacy of intangible heritage. Discover the history of the canal du Midi through anecdotes and by visiting and experiencing the must-see sites along the waterside!

History Designed in the 17th century by the engineer Pierre-Paul Riquet at Louis XIV's request and inaugurated in 1681, the canal du Midi runs for 240 kilometres and connects Toulouse to Sète, on the shores of the Mediterranean. An exceptional work of art, considered to be the largest construction site at the time (thousands of workers at work for 14 years), the canal du Midi opened a prosperous page in the history of river trade in the south of France by allowing goods, wheat, to pass from the Mediterranean to the Atlantic without going around the Iberian Peninsula since the Garonne was then navigable downstream from Toulouse to Bordeaux. Nowadays, with the canal de Garonne, cruise ships no longer sail on the river to Langon (on the outskirts of Bordeaux).

The village also lives thanks to the dynamism of the local traders: there are several restaurants and accommodation.

Capestang market in the morning

- 16:30 Arrival on the Canal du Midi, at the **9 Locks of Fonseranes** : stroll around the site, immersive cinema...

- 18:30 Short walk in downtown Béziers

 Then, a stroll in Béziers antique and mediaeval centre, with its "trompe l'oeil frescoes" and main monuments, shops...

- 14:00 Transfer by taxi (Radio-Taxi Béziers, 04 67 35 00 85) from the restaurant in Béziers to the round lock of Agde
