Montauban, town of Art and History, nine centuries old, is wearing well. Built of pink brick, it offers treasures such as the 17th century Place Nationale with its splendid arcades and surrounding old streets, its luxury private mansions, the view on the former Bishop's Palace from the Pont-Vieux (old bridge). The town has managed to keep its identity whilst renovating its architectural heritage, witness of a rich and eventful history. Must to see : the Church of Saint-Jacques, the Ingres Bourdelle museum, the Notre-Dame cathedral, the sculptures by Antoine Bourdelle scattered around the town.

09 am : Drive to Cordes sur Ciel, the first bastide founded in 1222.

Forget your heels! You don't drive up to Cordes-sur-ciel in a car either! The climb is on foot, through the steep, cobbled streets. Immerse yourself in the medieval atmosphere: fortified gates, ramparts, sculpted gothic facades and hidden corners. The charm works from the first step. From the top of this medieval town, you can look out over the world and contemplate the history.

Discover the fortified gates, the House of the Grand Veneur and the Grand Equerry and the many arts and crafts shops. Enjoy tasting some "Croquants de Cordes" at the "Musée des Arts du sucre et du chocolat Yves Thuriès".

Drive in lieu dit "le Pied Haut" : take "Rue de la République" and stop at the viewpoint indicated by a sign. Walk a few minutes and enjoy the panorama of Cordes sur Ciel.

The episcopal city of Albi has been listed on the UNESCO World Cultural Heritage register since July 2010. Cathédrale Sainte Cécile is the largest brick cathedral in the world. An unmissable architectural wonder, a must-see in the Tarn!

The tourist office (42 rue Mariès) will give you your Albi city pass and all the information to discover the city. In case of rain, you can visit the Toulouse Lautrec Museum, the largest public collection of the painter's works in the world.

Walk in Albi : Cathédrale Sainte-Cécile, Palais de la Berbie, cloître St-Salvy, Place Savène, Rue du Vieil Alby, place du chateau (with the #albi sculpture).
