The Aveyron river, born in Séverac-le-Château and flows into the Tarn. The section between Monteils, Najac and Laguépie, flows through beautiful, wild and charming wooded gorges. Canoeing is one of the few ways to truly appreciate the beauty of the Aveyron.

The Petit Tour de Najac: This is the classic route of the Aveyron Gorges! The Petit Tour de Najac allows a descent of 6kms in about 2 hours, with family or friends, all year long. This very playful descent is highly appreciated for its fitted out passages (stairs, slide, wave, slalom basin), but also its splendid views on the Fortress of Najac and its village.

At the top, the medieval fortress is integrated into a wild landscape where water, trees and rocks are combined. # **CLAIRVAUX LE PUECH DU PUOT**



PARKING : Salle des fêtes in Clairvaux

2 uren, 2 ½ uren met varian d de OOGTVERSCHIL : 300 m

Midden in de wijngaarden de heuvels van Clairvaux, Bruéjouls en Cassagnes en het grootste deel van het AOP

1 Vanuit het salle des fêtes linksaf om hoog op de hoofdstraar richting het centrum van het dorp. Tegenover de deur var de toren rechtsaf. Ga lets onderaan verder op het rue du Flou Ga verder naar links op een brede pad. Na Dourgnaguès volg de kleine weg naar links. In Bréjouls ga langs de rechterkant var de kerk. Na 150 m neem rue Carrière Cave en ga linksaf tot aar

de boerderij ga omhoog langs de beek van la Calconière aan het plateau. Op de hoogte van de boerderij van Is-seem de haarspeldbocht naar links. Bij het tweede kruis-rechtsaf en volg het pad voor 400 m.

3 Bij het kruispunt ga linksaf op het pad tot aan Panat. (300 m het kruispunt mogelijkheid om naar links te gaan om op en neer te lopen naar het Pusch de Piot – uitzicht op de dal van Clairvaux en het kasteel en wijngaard van Panat)

NIET TE MISSEN

4 Op de hoogte van de kerk steek de straat over om de weg nemen naar het château. Net voor het ingang neem link het straatje tussen de huizen. Bij de laatste huizen ga verder het pad dat steil om hoog gaat tot aan Clairveaux (glad in ge voor regen)


# EEN BEETJE GESCHIEDENIS

Je loopt deze middeleeuws dorp binnen door een versterkte poort onder een gekartelde ren. In 1060 de prins Alboin van Engeland, pelgrim van Conques, sticht een klooster waarv vandaag alleen de 12de-eeuws kerk nog bestaat – ten dele herbouwd in de 17de eeuw - n twee altaarstukken. Je kunt het wijnbouwdorp ontdekken met zijn smalle straatjes, ro zandsteen huizen en de deuren van de wijnkelders.

### **BRUÉIOULS**

Typische dorp met rode zandsteen huizen. De gotische kerk gewijd aan Saint Roch, verbouwd in 1784, hing af van de abdij van Brantôme. In de 15de eeuw had het dorp een leprozenhuis. Niet te missen op de kerk plein de grootste «tassou» (wijproever) van de wereld.

Deze hoge dorp gebouwd van gele kalksteen, gekroonde door de 11de-eeuws burcht-bouwd in de 17de-eeuw - van de machtige familie Panat, waarvan het wapenschild n zien is op het blazoen van Marcillac. Zijn romaanse kapel staat op de lijst van monume
