Taste of Toulouse offers English-speaking gastronomic tours that help you explore French gastronomy and culture and get in touch with passionate local artisans and businesses that make and sell some of the best products in Southwest France (cheese artisans, chocolatiers, bakers, butchers...). The visit ends with a shared lunch in the heart of the Victor Hugo market hall.

13.30: End of the tour, free time to enjoy your digital city pass and visit a museum

Toulouse is a city of science and adventure that you can discover on a complete tour in one afternoon. Walk through the noble district of **Les Carmes, through Ozenne Street** where the **Musée Paul Dupuy**, Musée des Arts Précieux is located. A Cabinets of curiosities housed in a former town house, currently showing works by feather artist Maxime Leroy.

Walk to **Place Saintes-Scarbes**, and the Jardin Royal, linked to the Jardin des plantes, around the **Natural History Museum of Toulouse** and **Le Quai des Savoirs** are located. These museums are free with the pass!

Even if the **Fondation Bemberg** is still being renovated, go check it's impressive Renaissance architecture and opt for the new exhibition of contemporary art at the **Musée les Abattoirs - Frac Occitanie. You'll can**



cross the "Pont Neuf bridge" or the pedestrian "Pont Saint-Pierre" to enter Toulouse left bank, Saint-Cyprien and enjoy the view till the museum.

To retrace the history of the city, dive into antiquity at the archaeological museum of the city, **the Musée Saint-Raymond.** For music lovers, go check "la fabrique de l'Opéra", new temporary exhibition at **Les Jacobins** to uncover Toulouse opera workshops where sets and costumes are made. The monuments is part of Toulouse unmissable with it's impressive architecture and inner cloister.

19.45: Diner offered to you at the restaurant Molette (20 minutes walk from the hotel) 8 Rue des Blanchers, 31000 Toulouse

A Toulouse restaurant for hungry bears. Traditional, generous home cooking using local, seasonal produce.

The Aeroscopia museum will take you right inside some of history's legendary aircraft. In the form of an airplane's fuselage, this 7,000m² building houses an exceptional collection: iconic aircraft, a historical fresco, and models of airplanes, as well as themed areas that are entertaining and interactive. You will be able to discover legendary and exceptional aircraft: the Concorde, the Airbus A 300B, the Super Guppy... but also civilian and military planes: Corvette, Falcon 10, Fouga Magister, Gazelle, Mirage 3C...
