Monday 27 May

10h20 Take off from Copenhagen airport to Montpellier on Norwegian flight D83628 – VOL RESERVES
 12h50 Arrival in Montpellier airport

- Pick up rental car at the AVIS desk at the airport Réf. dossier: 46138369FR4
 - Do not forget the AVIS rental voucher sent by e-mail (22 May) otherwise you will have to advance the rental fee yourself.
 - You don't need to refuel at the end of the rental period, which is taken care of by the Regional Tourism Board of Occitanie Tourisme.

At your expense: Toll Road charges, parking, fines (such as speeding, parking...).

Cycling is an original, eco-friendly and safe form of transport that fits into this leafy oasis to perfection. Soak up the real Mediterranean lifestyle in the peace of a green city. The sun city is bathed in light at nightfall with its many bars, restaurants and private beaches for a party atmosphere on the seafront.

16h Visit of La Grande Motte (either we go by car or by the tuk-tuk because it's far away) and the region from point zero, go to the Couchant district, to see: the POSEIDON viewpoint (awaiting confirmation from the roof), Cosmos Square, Sunset Beach. Then head for the city-centre and the





congress-center (we'll leave the car there) and walk to the port (I'll indicate to Niels-Henrik where to meet the boat), back to point zero.

Thau Lake (Etang de Thau), a feast for the senses

A fabulous lake, the biggest in Occitania (7500 hectares)! Thau Lake is packed with biodiversityand famous for its oyster farming. Shellfish producers serve their produce in lovely open-air cafés: try a few Bouzigues oysters washed down with some local wine (Muscats, Picpoul, Noilly-Prat etc.). Visit the Thau Lake Museum, nearby villages with character (Balaruc-le-Vieux, Poussan, Gigian etc.), the Loupian Gallo-Roman villa and beautiful Valmagne Abbey.

Lunch at **Les Jardins d'Oc** in Bouzigues, an oysterfarm on the Thau Lagoon





Visit of the <u>Musée de l'Etang de Thau</u>, to know much more about the history of oyster farming and traditional fishing in the Thau lagoon.

Visit of the <u>Noilly Prat cellar</u> with <u>Lisa</u> and tasting of this ancestral and unique vermouth. Also used in recipes, cocktails or simply as it is for an aperitif.

Emilie drives you back and leaves you in Sète for free time before dinner.
