12h45 Departure from Rotterdam/Den Haag til Bergerac on Transavia flight HV6081

14h15 Arrival in Bergerac

14h30 Pick up the rental car at the **AVIS** office at the airport

- Don't forget the AVIS rental voucher sent by e-mail on 7/08, otherwise you will have to pay the rental costs yourself.
- You don't need to fill up with petrol at the end of the rental period, as this is covered by the Comité Régional du Tourisme et des Loisirs d'Occitanie
- At your expense: tolls, parking charges, fines (speeding, parking, etc.).

Check in - 3:30pm is the last time to arrive in **Douelle** and receive the full instructions. Please note that you will not receive the full instructions on the day of arrival. You will therefore spend the first night on board in Douelle and receive the navigation instructions and lock instructions on the morning of Saturday, 6 September.

Don't forget to buy groceries for breakfast, lunch, etc.

• 1) - either in Bergerac before checking in at Douelle

If you choose to shop in Bergerac, please note that you will most likely arrive too late for check-in at 5 p.m. We can arrange a late arrival procedure if you arrive after 5.30 p.m. Please let us know your decision as soon as possible













#### • 2) - or in Cahors after checking in

Another, and perhaps better, option is to shop after checking in at Cahors or near Douelle. Please note that shopping time is limited. In Cahors, you will find Leclerc or Lidl, both of which are open until 8 p.m.

You can also go to Utile (closes at 7:45 p.m.) in Parnac (6 km from Douelle – approx. 7 minutes by car) or Intermarché (closes at 7:45 p.m.) in Espère (6.3 km – approx. 10 minutes away).

extraordinary colours at sunrise and sunset. The art gallery near the port showcases oil and pastel paintings depicting scenes from the Lot Valley. This charming gallery is run by Sally Davies and Jeffery Stride, a delightful couple who welcome visitors into their home,

where the gallery is located.

15h00 A meeting is scheduled for 15h at the workshop with Jeffrey. If you are running late,

please let them know at this number.

Their work is also featured in a beautiful temporary exhibition at the Henri Martin Museum in Cahors, on display until the end of the year — visiting it would be an excellent

way to round off your discovery.

Below the ruins of the fortress, the village boasts many beautiful old houses built in stone or wood between the 13th and 16th centuries.

**Laroque-des-Arcs**: Traces of the Roman aqueduct are still visible at Pech de Clary (right bank), as well as the ruins of the toll tower, where local lords once charged river users.

**Douelle**: Douelle was once the largest river port in the region. Upstream of the beautiful suspension bridge, don't miss the largest mural in Europe, painted by Chamizo and illustrating the history of Cahors wine. If you're a wine lover, several winemakers will be happy to introduce you to their wines, produced in the surrounding vineyards.

Wine estates to visit in Douelle (in order of proximity to the river):

- Domaine de Marcilhac
- Domaine Le Passelys (wine and cider)

Suggested visits (car rental required) — select according to your interests:

#### Luzech

Explore this charming village nestled in a natural meander of the Lot River. Wander through its picturesque streets and take in beautiful views over the water. You'll also discover:

The Notre-Dame de l'Île chapel, set in an idyllic location on the peninsula (chapel closed, but the surroundings are worth the walk)

Three small museums for heritage lovers:

- Musée Armand Viré (archaeology and local history)
- Ichnospace (dinosaur footprints and fossils)
- Planète des Moulins (mill technology)

#### **Albas**

Enjoy a walk through the picturesque village. You can also stop at:

- The Maison du Pal a freely accessible space offering heritage information
- Tuscan-style garden a charming green escape overlooking the Lot River

# Castelfranc

A small, charming bastide. Don't miss the Jardin des Sens, a medieval-inspired garden located at the confluence of the Vert and Lot rivers.

# **Saturday 13 September**

Morning:

Get in the rental car and make a stop in **Cahors** to experience **the wonderful market** you missed on Wednesday in Cahors. This is one of the most beautiful food markets in the region, held on the iconic square in front of the cathedral, where it has taken place for over 700 years. Enjoy the lively atmosphere and take the opportunity to shop for delicious local and fresh produce for lunch on the boat or to bring back as souvenirs.

Don't miss the chance to buy a "pastis" – a traditional Quercy-style apple cake, known for its incredibly thin layers of pastry and rich apple flavour. It's a true local delicacy and a great treat to enjoy onboard or share back home.

If you buy goat cheese to bring home, make sure you:

- Have it vacuum packed (odour!!!)
- Cheese in general, pack it in your suitcase (not in hand luggage). At customs, you risk them taking the cheese as you could have hidden something dangerous in the curd.

Lunch in Cahors at **Les Petits Producteurs** (offered by OT Cahors Vallée du Lot) – *NB! It is important that you arrive at 12 noon and no later.*

#### Free visit in the afternoon

- Mont St Cyr <u>WEB</u> Take a drive up Mont St Cyr, which offers a magnificent view over Cahors, set in a meander of the River Lot.
- Musee Henri Martin Free visit of the museum (2 tickets offered one ticket at your charge : 9€). Dive into Cahors' artistic heritage at this beautiful museum. The exhibition by Sally Davies and Jeffery Stride, which you may have already discovered a few days ago at





their gallery, continues here in a new setting. A nice way to extend your artistic journey in the Lot.

• Villa Cahors-Malbec Lounge: Enjoy a free wine tasting experience at the Malbec Lounge, located within the Cahors Tourist Office. Thanks to the oenomatics (wine dispensers), 7 to 8 different wines are available at any given time. Just ask for a tasting card at the front desk. Opening hours: from 9:30 am to 6:30 pm (opens 30 minutes after the Tourist Office, and closes 30 minutes before).

and underestimated **Ossip Zadkine Museum** - <u>WEB</u> - It's a small museum and will not take long. He is considered to be one of the greatest masters of Cubist sculpture. Zadkine lived and worked in Paris, his wife was from Montauban (south of Cahors) and they had a

second house in Les Arques which today is a museum.
